First Announcement & Call for Papers

Singapore is a southeast Asian city-state off the southern tip of the Malay Peninsula. With slightly over 5 million people, our country is highly diverse; the majority are Chinese, with Malays and Indians. Reflecting this diversity, we have 4 official languages: Chinese, Malay, Tamil and English as the national medium of communication. As a leading financial centre, the economy depends heavily on exports and refining imported goods. In recent years, the Government has also invested heavily in safety education and research.

This Symposium is a continued effort of the previous six international symposia held in Korea (1999, 2007), Japan (2001, 2009), Chinese Taipei (2003) and China (2005). This Symposium is organised by the Singapore Institution of Safety Officers (SISO).

The aim of this Symposium is to exchange up-to-date information and knowledge to prevent occupational accidents. Selected papers will be presented in the oral and poster sessions with safety and health-related topics, talks and seminars.

We are inviting all safety and health experts, researchers, engineers and government officials to submit abstracts for this Symposium. Deadline for submission is **31 May 2013**.

At the same time, we also urge everyone to attend this Symposium and enjoy the opportunity to share recent safety research experiences in this field.

Selection of abstracts will be based on its relevance to the objectives and theme of the Conference.

- Submission of Full Manuscript / Presentation Slides – By 15 July 2013
