No recording, videotaping, or photography of any kind is permitted, except by the organizers, regardless of whether you are participating on-site or online. [Updated on Oct 28, 2024] There will be no archive distribution, even after the meeting. Participant registration is required, including oral speakers, poster presenters and invitees. All presenters are required to visit the on-site venue. The proceedings will be published in PDF format. A printed version will be available for purchase to those who wish, at an additional cost to the participation fee.
